

The OPTIONS Philosophy

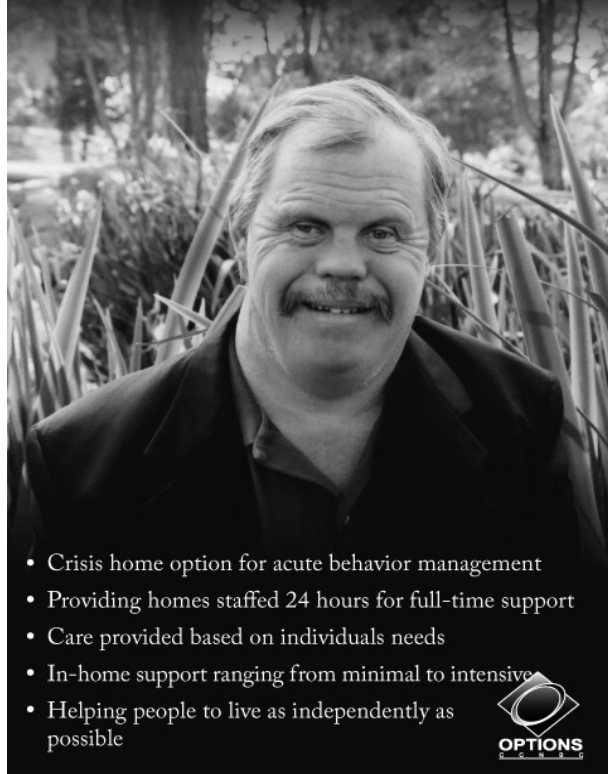

In 1984, Chief Executive Officer Mike Mamot started a single group home for disabled and abused children. Now on a daily basis, OPTIONS serves over 200 individuals in northern Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo counties.

We provide comprehensive services in housing, community-based day programs, and training in independent living skills—from one-on-one support and functional services, to vocational services and community integration, as well as social and recreational needs.

By increasing self-reliance, we will improve the quality of life for those we serve.

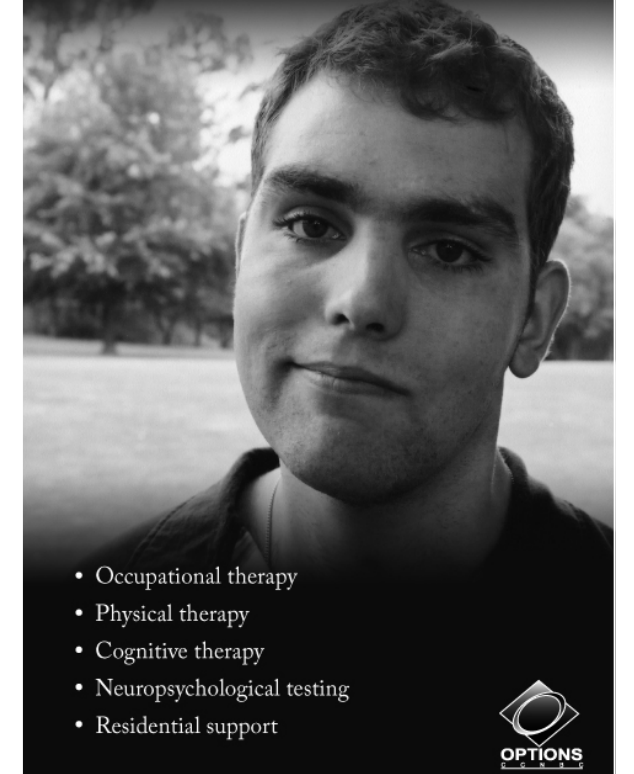


- Job training and support in real work environments

HEAD TRAUMA AND REHABILITATION SERVICES

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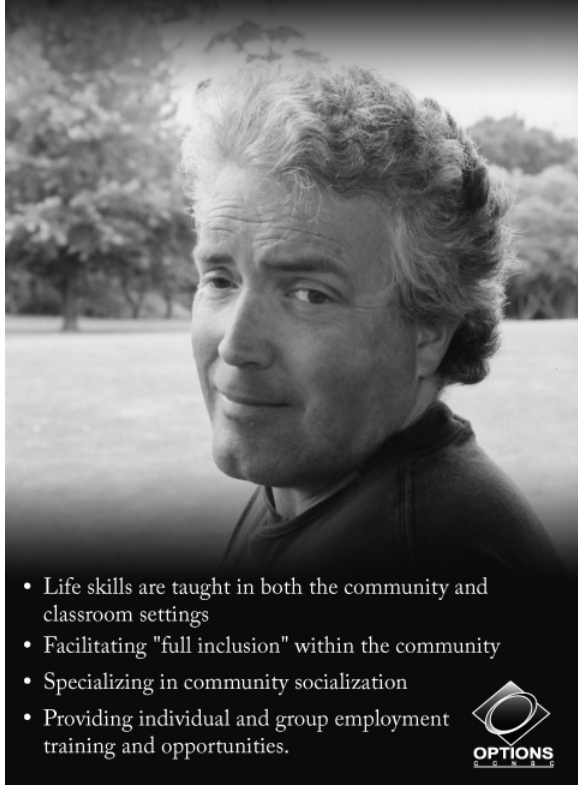
